Active Shooter (Anti-Terrorism) Response Training for Law Enforcement
2-Day Training

Day One

Course	Length	Description
1. Introduction	1 hr	Participants will receive a course overview of the active shooter response training.
2. Active Shooter Statistics in the United States	1 hr	Course will discuss the current active shooter statistics around the United States, as we discuss current law enforcement response training.
3. Hostage Barricade vs. Active Shooter	1 hr	Course will cover differences/similarities between hostage barricade and active shooter. Tactical application and principles of working alone or as a direct response team.
4. Team Movement Tactics	2 hrs	Course will discuss Israeli counter terrorism team movement methods prior to entry. Instruction will be conducted in practical exercise with teams of two.
5. Limited Room Entry & Clearing	3 hrs	Course will discuss limited room entry tactics for one and two person teams. Room clearing and stack up tactics will be taught and practiced.

Day Two

Course	Length	Description
6. Cold & Hot Entry into a building or room	2 hrs	Course will discuss procedures for entry into a room or building utilizing cold and hot entry techniques and methods for a locked or barricaded room. Individuals will also be instructed on methods and considerations to be used for potential casualties with the use of each entry method.

7. Post Engagement	2 hrs	Course will discuss priority of actions to be considered once an active shooter threat has been neutralized. Security set up, triage and evacuation of injured and wounded. Command center set procedures for follow up responders and bystanders.
8. Scenario Based Drills	3 hrs	Course will set up scenario based drills for participants to respond to in both one and two person teams. Individuals and groups will be presented with multiple scenarios requiring immediate contact with Active Shooter through the use of building and room entry, room clearing, threat identification, and threat neutralization. Each scenario will be video recorded by instructor for debrief review.
9. De-brief Review	1 hr	Course will review video recordings from scenario based drills. Individuals will have the opportunity to comment and critique all of the scenarios from course 8. On-site remediation can be conducted.
